

**Sunday Morning League Shooting:** 11:00 AM until 1:00 PM. As in the past, we are planning on offering a time for adult league shooting on Sunday mornings before the Family program gets going. If you can't make it during the week to shoot your league scores, this is the time for you to make up these scores.

### League Information:

**Vegas:** Shoot 3 spot target, 3 shot groups, 30 arrows, and individual scoring.

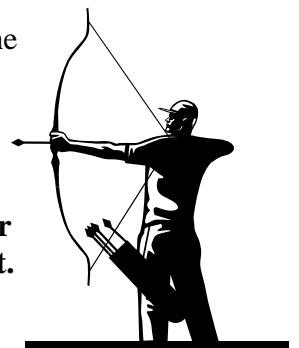
**5 Spot:** Shoot 5 spot target, 5 shot groups, 60 arrows, team scoring. You and a partner add scores together for total team score.

### US Military Members & Shooting:

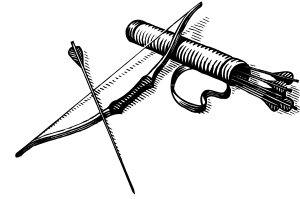
Currently serving military are eligible for a free WAC membership. Honorably discharged personnel are eligible for free first year WAC membership. WBH membership (required) is still their responsibility. **Weekend shoots and weekly league shooting is free for currently serving personnel.**

**Club Tools:** For those members who wish to chronograph their bows, the club has purchased a chronograph and it will be located at the indoor for members to use. We also now have a paper tuning device located at the indoor range; members can use to paper tune their bows if they wish.

**Club work hours and sign in will be posted at the Indoor. Remember to note your participation hours for credit towards your requirement.**

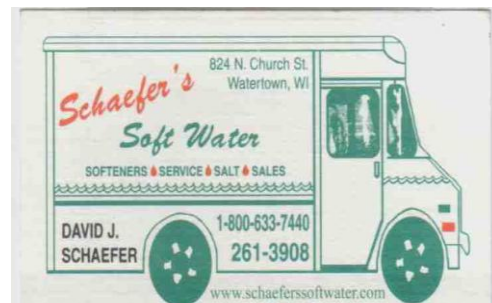
